OUR SPECIAL PROJECTS



E-SHIKSHA - TEACHING WITH TABLETS

- The tablet program is implemented at cluster (group of 30 villages) level
- Each school is given three tablets
- Good curated content from different sources are presented using the tablets
- Teachers are trained effectively on using the tablets in

DONATION NEEDED \$15,000

Covers 30 Schools.

TAILORING TRAINING CENTER

- Three-month program
- Hub-and-spoke model – Central training centers train women who open satellite training centers in their village
- Graduates can earn up to **Rs. 5,000/month**
- Self-help group established at the training center to connect women to large-scale market opportunities.

DONATION NEEDED \$30,000

Covers capital expenditures and operating expenses for 3 years.





EKAL ON WHEELS

- Three Month Digital Literacy Course
- Course provided to **54 students** in **9 Villages** every **3 months**
- Students earn a certificate from the Spoken Tutorial project at IIT Bombay
- Graduates can earn up to **Rs. 15,000/month**

DONATION NEEDED \$70,000

Covers capital expenditures and operating expenses for 3 years.

INTEGRATED VILLAGE DEVELOPMENT

The following interventions are provided to ensure a pathway to a self-reliant (Atma Nirbhar) healthy village community

- **Ekal Vidyalaya** (K-3) Augmented with E-Shiksha - Literacy and Digital Literacy
- **Ekal Arogya** - Health and Hygiene
- **Gramothan** - Skill Development
 - Tailoring Training Centers for Women
 - Computer Training Center - Basic and Advanced Computer Training
 - Other Skill Training as Appropriate for the Region
 - Poshan Vatika - Provide fruit trees and vegetables seedlings to farmers
 - Work with farmers to improve agricultural outputs and income

In addition, the program works to identify special government programs that can be brought to the villages.

TELEMEDICINE

- Local women are trained to use a mobile phone based telemedicine toolkit
- The toolkit help triage common ailments
- Villagers who need special attention are connected to a doctor using videoconferencing and prescription is provided
